Joining the project does not result in land designation or a binding legal agreement. Instead we are a **supportive network**, working together for sustainable land-use and landscape recovery.

We ask our members to agree to a pledge for nature, as the **unifying commitment** of the Weald to Waves network. Together, we then **map your land** using LandApp to identify habitats and inform our free advice. If you are happy to do so, we will then add your pledge to our online map.
