

# BioBox Loan Scheme Agreement

The Weald to Waves BioBox Loan Scheme is designed to encourage and support groups and organisations to undertake biological recording in their local area by establishing ad-hoc or long term monitoring schemes, or to be used in education and engagement activities such as "bioblitzes". **The scheme allows the borrowing of equipment boxes ("BioBoxes") containing the ecological survey equipment designed for monitoring a wide range of species groups**, including plants, terrestrial mammals, bats, freshwater and terrestrial invertebrates, birds, and reptiles.

We do not charge for the loan of these boxes, but expect that they should be treated carefully and used responsibly for the purpose defined above, with due regard to health and safety.

This agreement is entered into between **Knepp Wildland Foundation** (the "Lender") and the "Borrower" (see 1. Loan Period) regarding the temporary loan of a BioBox containing ecological survey equipment.

## 2. Equipment Contents and Return of BioBoxes

The Borrower much ensure that the BioBox is returned to the Lender on or before the **End Date** specified above. It is the Borrower's responsibility to ensure that the contents of the BioBoxes match the checklist below upon receipt of the box, and prior to returning. If the Borrower does not inform the Lender of any loss or damage, the Lender is entitled to assume that the box is complete and in good condition.

The Borrower confirms receipt of the Equipment in good condition and acknowledges responsibility for all listed items.

## 3. Use of Equipment

The Equipment is to be used **solely for the purpose of ecological surveying for data collection and education**. The Borrower agrees to follow applicable laws, ethical guidelines, and any instructions provided by the Lender.

The Equipment must only be used on land which the Borrower owns or has **permission from the landowner to access** *and* **survey**. The Borrower agrees to use the Equipment in the manner specified in the accompanying guidance and not to alter or misuse the Equipment.

The Borrower has an active obligation to ensure that the BioBoxes are used in a safe and responsible manner. This includes:

- Ensuring that all **health and safety instructions** provided in this contract and in the accompanying instructions are adhered to.
- Conducting appropriate **risk assessments** before surveys or events. Examples of appropriate templates for surveying and events are provided below:

- Ensuring that **all users are briefed** and aware of health and safety considerations before using the BioBoxes.
- Ensuring that the BioBoxes are **used under supervision**, particularly when children are involved. When conducting any surveys around water, such as pond dipping, children MUST be kept under close supervision.

## 4. Care and Maintenance

Each BioBox is a valuable resource for biological recording, with their approximate value being £1,500. The Borrower agrees to handle the Equipment provided with care and return it in the same condition as received, allowing for normal wear and tear. The Borrower shall report any damage, loss, or malfunction to the Lender immediately.

## 6. Data Collection

The purpose of the BioBoxes is to encourage communities to record and learn about wildlife in local spaces. While we do not charge for the use of BioBoxes, we do ask that the Borrower makes an effort to submit results back to us through iRecord, under the Weald to Waves activity, ensuring that this data can inform ecologists across Sussex. We also ask that the Borrower fills in the attached feedback form, to ensure we can continue to improve this scheme.

## 5. Liability

The Borrower assumes full responsibility for the BioBox during the loan period and agrees to repair or replace any items lost or damaged beyond normal use. The equipment is for the use of the Borrower and any groups or entities they represent and must not be loaned onwards.

## 6. Ownership

The Equipment remains the property of the Lender.

## 7. Termination

The Lender reserves the right to terminate this agreement and request the return of the BioBoxes at any time, with reasonable notice.
