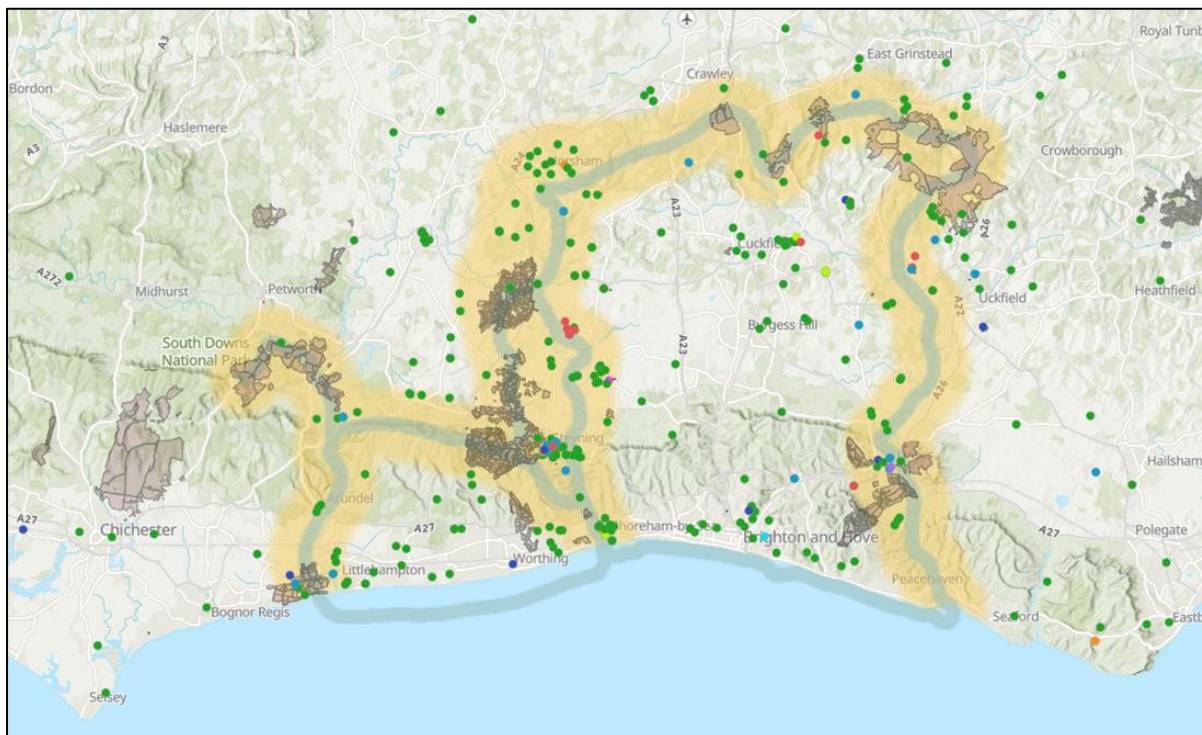


Create your own Weald to Waves Maps

By showing the growing numbers of people signed up to Weald to Waves (pledges) in each local area, we hope to demonstrate how whole communities can drive nature recovery, and how anyone can get involved in their own space, whatever its size or to improve habitat connectivity across the landscape. That is why we urge people to **Join the Corridor and Join the Dots!**

We suggest printing your own local map showing the pledges for your area, to show at your event. Use the instructions below to find out how.



1. Visit the Weald to Waves corridor map:

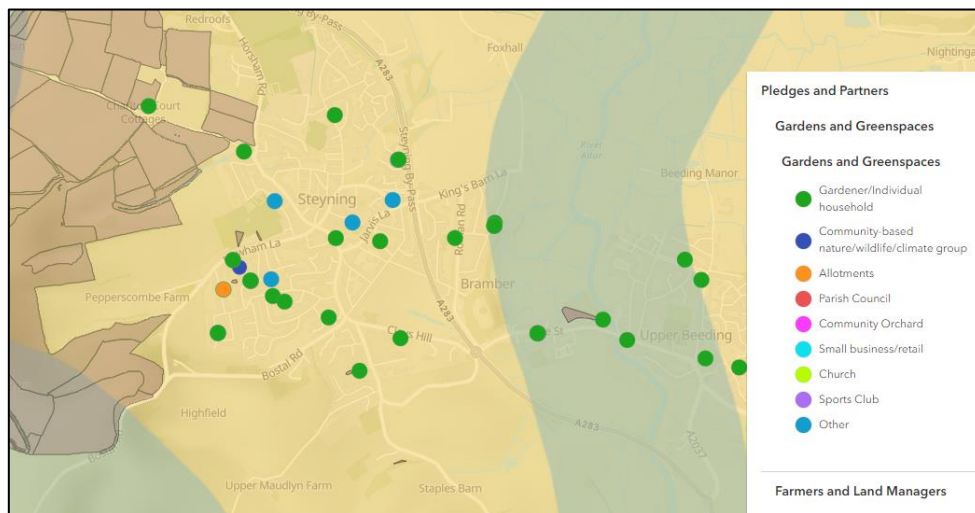
- Open your web browser and go to the Weald to Waves website.
- Navigate to the [corridor map section](#).

2. Activate the pledges layer:

- On the map interface, find the layers tab on the left-hand side.
- Ensure that the pledges layers are turned on. This will display the locations of individuals who have made pledges.
- *Note: if you zoom in too far, the pledges will disappear. This is a deliberate feature to protect individuals' privacy.*

3. Capture and print the map:

- Use the zoom controls to focus on your local area.
- Once you have the desired view, take a screenshot of the map.
- Print the screenshot to use for your event.



4. Explore other maps:

- Try switching on other layers in the map, to explore different features.
- You can also explore our [Opportunities](#), and [Pressures](#) maps.
- Use these maps to create additional visual aids that highlight the situation for wildlife in your area.
